


Activities of Equity Mutual Fund Schemes - June 2024

Emerging Investment Patterns in Equity Mutual Fund Scheme Categories

- The equity mutual fund landscape experienced a remarkable transformation, with Net Assets Under Management (AUM) soaring to an unprecedented ₹27.67 Lakh Crs in June. This historic milestone was fueled by a robust market rally, record-breaking SIP contributions and notable New Fund Offerings, marking a new era of growth and investor confidence.
- In June, equity mutual fund schemes witnessed an extraordinary surge, with net inflows soaring to ₹40,608
 Crs, surpassing the previous record of ₹34,697 Crs set in May.
- In 2024, investment momentum is strongly geared towards Sectoral/Thematic Funds, Multi Cap Funds, Large
 & Mid Cap Funds and Flexi Cap Funds, making them top choices for investors seeking strategic portfolio diversification.
- In the first half of 2024, Equity Mutual Funds attracted massive inflows totaling ₹1,65,502 Crs, with a significant 42% of these investments channeled into Sector/Thematic Funds alone. This trend persisted in June, with an impressive ₹22352 Crs or 55% of June inflows being allocated to Sector/Thematic Funds.
- Multi Cap Funds, Large & Mid Cap Funds, and Flexi Cap Funds also performed well, each garnering more than ₹15,000 crore in the first half of 2024. This indicates a strong diversification within the mutual fund industry.
- In the realm of open-ended equity schemes excluding ETFs and Index Funds, SBI Mutual Fund stood out as the prime beneficiary of equity inflows for June, securing over 25% of the total equity inflows. Together SBI, HDFC, Nippon, ICICI, Kotak, quant, Motilal and PPFAS AMCs captured more than 75% of the total equity inflows for the month. On the other hand, Axis, Mirae and UTI AMCs experienced net redemptions during the same period.
- Despite the negative news of SEBI's investigation, quant AMC received net inflows exceeding ₹2,000 Crs.

Breaking Down Equity Inflows of June

- In June, Sectoral/Thematic Funds maintained their dominance in attracting equity inflows with capturing investor interest. Eleven Equity NFOs, including the SBI Automotive Opportunities Fund, Aditya Birla SL Quant Fund and Kotak Special Opportunity Fund, garnered ₹14,370 crore.
- Past NFOs of 2024 from the Sectoral/Thematic category, such as the HDFC Manufacturing Fund and SBI Energy Opportunity Fund continued to attract substantial inflows.
- Following a strong collection from NFOs, the Parag Parikh Flexi Cap Fund maintained its position among the top 5 schemes for equity inflows. Additionally, the SBI Contra Fund continued its impressive streak, attracting substantial equity inflows for the sixth consecutive month in June.
- In the passive fund sector, the major beneficiaries of equity inflows in June were the HDFC Index Fund-Nifty Plan, ICICI Pru BSE Sensex ETF, SBI Nifty 50 ETF, SBI BSE Sensex ETF, and Nippon India ETF BSE Sensex.

Uncovering Trends in Equity Scheme Portfolios for June, 2024

- Many equity mutual fund schemes have demonstrated a significant inclination towards fresh investments in well-established companies such as Indus Towers, Craftsman Automation, Mphasis, ZF Commercial Vehicle Control Systems, Transformers & Rectifiers, Kotak Mahindra Bank, The Ramco Cements, HDFC Bank, Interglobe Aviation, Mahindra & Mahindra, Samvardhana Motherson International and Hindustan Unilever.
- Additionally, they have shown a preference for new investments in IPOs, including Stanley Lifestyles, Dee Development Engineers,, Allied Blenders and Le Travenues Technology.
- Several equity schemes have strategically exited their holdings in companies such as ONGC, REC, NHPC, NTPC, BHEL, Max Financial Services, Container Corporation of India, Adani Power, Canara Bank, Punjab National Bank, Bank of Baroda, IndusInd Bank and Coforge.
- Overall, equity mutual fund schemes have been actively acquiring shares in prominent companies such as HDFC Bank, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Indus Towers, Infosys, Maruti Suzuki and Mphasis.
- Among the most traded stocks, there was a notable selloff in Cummins India, Bharat Electronics, Hindustan Aeronautics, State Bank of India, Bharti Airtel and NTPC.
- In addition to the previously mentioned stocks, significant trading activity was observed in the
 mid-cap and small-cap segments. Among the top-traded mid-cap stocks, several equity schemes
 preferred to sell Cummins India, Bharat Forge and Container Corporation of India. Conversely,
 many schemes invested in stocks such as ICICI Lombard General Insurance, Alkem Laboratories,
 Gland Pharma, L&T Finance and ZF Commercial Vehicle Control Systems.
- Among the most actively traded small-cap stocks, various equity schemes directed their investments towards companies such as Craftsman Automation, Kalpataru Projects, The Ramco Cements, Sansera Engineering, Aster DM Healthcare and Sun TV Network. Concurrently, there was notable disinvestment from Whirlpool of India, Cholamandalam Financial Holdings and Crompton Greaves Consumer Electricals.
