


Activities of Equity Mutual Fund Schemes - October 2024

Emerging Investment Patterns in Equity Mutual Fund Scheme Categories

- Equity Mutual Funds Show Resilience Amid Market Downturn: Despite a sharp equity market decline, equity
 mutual funds displayed strength in October, closing with Net Assets Under Management (AUM) near ₹29.89
 Lakh Crs. This stability was supported by record SIP contributions and significant inflows from New Fund
 Offerings, marking a phase of renewed investor confidence and growth for the industry.
- Record-Breaking Inflows in Equity MFs Amid Market Correction: Monthly net inflows into equity mutual fund schemes surged 22% M-o-M in October, hitting a new peak of ₹41,887 Crs, surpassing the previous record of ₹40,608 Crs set in June, despite a sharp stock market correction.
- 2024 Investment Focus Shifts to Sectoral/Thematic: In 2024, investment momentum is strongly geared towards Sectoral/Thematic, Multi Cap, Flexi Cap and Large & Mid Cap Funds, making them prime picks for investors seeking strategic portfolio diversification.
- Sector/Thematic Funds Lead Equity MF Segment for Fourth Month: For the fourth straight month, Sector/Thematic Funds have topped the Equity Mutual Fund segment with a Net AUM of ₹4,58,204 Crs, closely trailed by Flexi Cap Funds at ₹4.34 Lakh Crs.
- Sector/Thematic Funds Capture Major Share of Equity MF Inflows in 2024: Equity Mutual Funds attracted a robust ₹3.17 Lakh Crs in inflows this year, with Sector/Thematic Funds claiming 42% of the total. In October, this trend persisted, with ₹12,278 Crs-30% of monthly inflows-directed to these funds.
- ICICI Pru Leads October Equity Inflows: In the realm of open-ended equity schemes excluding ETFs and Index Funds, ICICI Pru Mutual Fund emerged as the top beneficiary of equity inflows in October, capturing over 12% of the total. Collectively, ICICI Pru, SBI, Nippon, Kotak, Motilal Oswal and HDFC AMCs secured more than 60% of the month's total equity inflows. Meanwhile, UTI AMC faced net redemptions during the same period.

Breaking Down Equity Inflows of October

- October Marks All-Category Inflow Milestone for Equity Funds: In October, for the first time this
 year, all categories of equity funds recorded positive net inflows, reflecting broad-based investor
 interest across the equity segment.
- Inflows of Sectoral/Thematic Funds Boosted by Key NFOs: In October, Sectoral/Thematic Funds
 continued to dominate equity inflows, capturing strong investor interest. Notable Equity NFOs,
 such as Kotak MNC Fund and LIC MF Manufacturing Fund, collectively garnered ₹4,047 Crs,
 further reinforcing their appeal in the market.
- Top Schemes Shine in October Equity Inflows: Motilal Oswal Midcap Fund, Parag Parikh Flexi Cap Fund, SBI Contra Fund and Nippon India Large Cap Fund remained among the top 5 schemes for equity inflows, while SBI Contra Fund continued its impressive streak, attracting substantial equity inflows for the tenth consecutive month in October.
- Broader Inflows in October: In addition to top schemes, HDFC Flexi Cap Fund, ICICI Pru Bluechip
 Fund, ICICI Pru Infrastructure Fund, ICICI Pru India Opportunities Fund, and ICICI Pru Bharat
 Consumption Fund saw notable inflows in October, highlighting diverse investor interest across
 these funds.

Uncovering Trends in Equity Scheme Portfolios for October, 2024

- Equity Mutual Fund Schemes Invest in Hyundai Motor India IPO, Highlighting October's Largest Debut: A total of 77 equity mutual fund schemes showed strong interest in October's largest IPO, Hyundai Motor India. Other prominent IPOs, including Waaree Energies and Afcons Infrastructure Ltd., also drew investments from numerous equity schemes, underscoring fund managers' focus on high-potential market entrants for portfolio growth.
- Top New Investment Picks by Equity Mutual Funds: Several equity mutual fund schemes have demonstrated a strong preference for fresh investments in companies such as Mahindra & Mahindra, Angel One, 360 One Wam, Torrent Pharmaceuticals, Coforge, National Aluminium Company, PB Fintech and Dixon Technologies.
- Equity Schemes Exit Key Positions in Major Companies: Several equity schemes have fully exited their positions in companies such as Avenue Supermart, Tata Motors, Bharat Electronics, Indus Towers, Mphasis, Tata Steel, HAL, Honeywell Automation India, Global Health, ONGC, Oil India and Credit Access Gramin.
- Equity Mutual Funds Accumulate in Market Leaders, Trim Positions in Select Stocks: Overall, equity mutual fund schemes have been actively accumulating shares in prominent companies like Mahindra & Mahindra, Coforge, Zomato, ICICI Bank, Bajaj Auto and Bajaj Finance, reflecting their strong confidence in these market leaders. Among the most traded stocks, there was a notable selloff in Tata Motors, HCL Technologies and HDFC AMC.
- Mid-Cap Moves: Among the top-traded mid-cap stocks, many schemes invested in companies such
 as Coforge, Dixon Technologies, Max Healthcare Institute, Polycab India, HPCL and PAYTM.
 Meanwhile, several equity schemes chose to sell holdings in Sona BLW Precision Forgings, Voltas
 and Mphasis.
- Small-Cap Shifts: Among the most actively traded small-cap stocks, various equity schemes
 directed their investments towards companies such as Balrampur Chini Mills, Sansera Engineering,
 360 One Wam, Angel One, Birlasoft and Firstsource Solutions, while notable disinvestment
 occurred in GE Vernova T&D India, MCX, Whirlpool of India and Aether Industries.
